



# Geospatial Mapping of Population Need to Allied Health Workforce Supply

HealthWork Mapping geospatially maps allied health practitioner supply against the population *need* for allied health services, to Statistical Area Level 3 granularity. *Need* (versus demand) is defined using profession-specific population-demographic-based drivers of need for a profession's services, weighted and synthesised into our novel algorithmic, the *Allied Health Index of Need*.
